## Every Child Counts: Restoring Learning for Migrant Families in Bihar:-

In our efforts to support the education of migrant children, we witnessed remarkable progress during our visit to the Masuda and Bhatbigha villages in Nawada District, Bihar. From July 28th to 29th, our team engaged with the local community under the Brick Field Campsite Education Program, focusing on the 173 children aged 3-14 who recently returned from the brick kilns.

As the migration season concluded in June, families began their journey back to their native villages, bringing the critical challenge of reestablishing educational continuity for their children. Our initiative sought to bridge this gap by facilitating a smooth transition into formal education. Through close collaboration with local school authorities and community leaders, we successfully enrolled 33 children who had previously been out of school into nearby government institutions. A special acknowledgment goes to the Mukhiya of Masuda village, whose dedication was crucial in mobilizing community support. His commitment to organizing Aadhaar enrolment camps played a significant role in overcoming hurdles that hindered school admissions. The response from the community was heartening, with many previously unlisted families stepping forward, eager for their children to seize educational opportunities. In total, 75% of the children who returned home successfully enrolled in formal education. These results showcase the power of grassroots collaboration and the importance of timely interventions. Together, we are making strides toward ensuring that every migrant child has access to the education they deserve, reaffirming our commitment to their future.



## Pledge towards a Greener tomorrow : Plantation Drive

**Towards Future**, in collaboration with **Ambuja Neotia**, conducted a series of Plantation initiatives aimed at fostering environmental awareness and encouraging community engagement in the preservation of nature. Children made handmade rakhis, sang songs, and shared stories about friendship, care, and solidarity, highlighting the universal values of love and mutual respect. The event became a beautiful expression of unity in diversity, where children and community members came together to reaffirm that compassion and trust are the threads that connect everyone—beyond customs, faiths, and differences.

### Strategic Progress and Commitment: Insights from the Annual General Body Meeting:

During this quarter, the Annual General Body Meeting was convened, serving as a pivotal forum for the review of



progress, the sharing of accomplishments, and the establishment of strategic priorities for the upcoming year. A collective vision of empowering women and children was reaffirmed by the members, with continued emphasis placed on education, the safeguarding of rights, and the promotion of sustainable livelihoods. The commitment to transparency, collaboration, and fostering a long-term impact within the community was highlighted during the meeting.

### Women Empowerment

As the first cohort of skill development training concluded in June, there was a notable demand for enrolment in the second cohort among women participating in various skill



development initiatives. **Towards Future** has collaborated with **Calcutta Foundation** to establish a skill development center, '**Apni Kutir**,' located in the Rajarhat area. This center provides training in Tailoring, Mehendi application, Beauty Care, and Digital Literacy. Additionally, Towards Future started a tailoring training unit in Mohammadpur. In the second cohort, more than **200 women** successfully enrolled in the two centers, underscoring the commitment to enhancing skills within the community. Furthermore, capacity-building training on financial literacy was delivered to 50 women leaders, thereby strengthening the support for women's empowerment.

### Strengthening the Circle of Child Protection

**Talash** conducted 3 sessions on Children Safety Training, for teachers of Towards Future, focusing on



personal safety and child protection. The session empowered educators to create safer, more supportive environments for children.


